## The Pattern for Worshipping God

---

### The importance of heeding God's authority in worship

1. Leviticus 10:1-2

**Yes – No** Was the fire that Nadab and Abihu used authorized by God?

2. Matthew 15:8,9

THOUGHT QUESTION: How were these people worshipping God in Vain?

3. 2 John 9; Colossians 3:17

### The pattern for Christian worship in the first century church (Acts 1 & 2)

#### *Assemble*

4. Hebrews 10:22-25 (Fill in blank at bottom)

THOUGHT QUESTION: What is the purpose of assembling with the saints?

5. Acts 2:41-42

### *Teach*

6. Matthew 28:19-20 (Fill in the blank at the end)

### *Pray*

**Yes – No** Are we commanded to pray?

10. Acts 2:42

**Yes – No** Was prayer included in their worship?

### *Lord's Supper*

12. 1 Corinthians 11:17-29,33-34

**Yes – No** Did Paul say "as often" as we partake the Lord's Supper we proclaim His death?

13. Acts 20:7

**Yes – No** Did these Christians meet on the 1st day of the week (Sunday) to partake of the Lord's Supper?

**Yes – No** Should Christians today meet on any other day to partake of the Lord's Supper?

### *Sing*

14. Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16 (Fill in the blank at the end)

**Yes – No** Does the New Testament teach that we should sing and make music "in your heart" to the Lord?

**Yes – No** Do these passages mention a mechanical instrument of music?

**Yes – No** When we "sing" and make "music in the heart" should we also "teach" and "admonish" and "speak"?

**Yes – No** Is it by the fruit of our lips that we are to offer in sacrifices of praise?
